POSITION DEFINITION:

Technician Intern will be responsible for assisting with tree planting, grass seeding's, shoreline restoration plantings, stream monitoring, buffer staking, educational programming, and general assistance with all programs offered through the district.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Technician Intern will be responsible for assisting with tree planting including installation of weed barrier fabric, grass seeding's using no-till drill and tractor, pulling gooseneck trailers with equipment, assist with shoreline restoration plantings, stream monitoring, observation well monitoring, buffer staking using GPS equipment, educational programming including the fair, and general assistance with all programs offered through the district. This position is meant to assist and will serve as a good opportunity for an individual to gain experience and begin a career in the natural resources or environmental field. May involve other duties as assigned to complete work related District programs and activities.
