 - a) Chippewa River Watershed Meeting-Kovarik

Provided an update on the meeting held with Chippewa River Watershed project discussing grant writing for this next opening round. The Chippewa River Watershed project will begin writing the main parts of the grant for two sub watersheds between Pope and Swift Counties and will attain the number and type of projects from Swift County for the application. This is for the tributary of the Chippewa River and includes most of Barsness and Rolling Forks Townships only. The CRWP will serve an overall administrative role for the grant and the SWCD will continue to do the project development, technical and engineering components of each project.

The SWCD intends to apply for the 8 lake TMDL areas as we have in the past for applications.

The application will be opening up in July sometime.

b) **Rosholt**-Kovarik
